5. **Character certificate from the institution last attended or from the designated authority as mentioned in the prospectus**
6. **Copy of Aadhaar Card**
7. **Certificate(s) supporting the reservation(s) claimed and affidavit(s) (gap year, single girl child etc.)**
8. **The language/format of the certificate/affidavit and the issuing authority should strictly be as mentioned in the prospectus.**
9. **Certificate(s) supporting the weightages claimed e.g., NCC, NSS etc.**
10. **Two passport-size photographs**

***It is mandatory for all the applicants to fill the admission form at <https://admission.davchd.ac.in/>.**

Note:

1. The admission will be given after checking the eligibility and the verification of the original documents and will be governed by the existing rules of Panjab University, Chandigarh, and the Department of Higher Education (Chandigarh) as mentioned in the Admission Prospectus.
2. Any further rules/conditions communicated from time to time by the Panjab University, Chandigarh, and the Department of Higher Education (Chandigarh) shall automatically apply to the ongoing admission process.
3. The choice of MDC and SEC papers offered to the students will be subject to the availability of seats in those subjects. If the seats are filled, the students will be asked to choose other MDC/SEC subjects, as the case may be and wherever applicable.
4. The students must go through the list of papers in the relevant category available on the college website and come prepared with a second option if such a need arises. The Admission Committee members will help the students choose an alternate paper/combination in case they are not able to make a choice themselves.
