- i. **UT Pool Candidates:** Those who have passed lower qualifying examination as regular candidates from schools and colleges in UT, Chandigarh.
- ii. **General Pool Candidates:** Those who have passed lower qualifying examination from schools and colleges outside UT, Chandigarh.

**** General U.T. Pool candidates to report on 20 July, 2017, at 10 am and submit their complete set of documents for verification.**

- Inclusion of name in the provisional merit lists does not guarantee candidate a seat.
- The seat can only be confirmed after proper verification of all the original documents of the candidate on the admission date as per the availability of the seats.
- Seat will only be confirmed after deposition of fees.
- Student/s belonging to any of the Reserve Categories (SC/ST/PCP/Def/FF/ ETC.) will be first considered in the general category according to their position in the combined provisional merit lists. If admitted on the basis of merit in the general open category, their seats will not be counted towards the seats reserved for their respective categories concerned, so that their seats are offered in order of merit to the next candidate of the Reserved Category.
- So all the general and reserve candidates shall have to appear in person, on the notified date(s) of Counselling accordingly.
- Physical presence in the counselling is mandatory for all the candidates with the required documents on the notified dates.
- De-resevation of seats of the Reserved Categories, if any will take place on 25.07.2017.
